First Annual Interleague Action Pistol Shoot **Saturday, September 9th from 12:00 P.M. to 2:00 P.M.**

Please join us for fun and exciting shooting stages. All of the courses are set to different defensive scenarios to test the skills of every Marine or shooter. This is a timed and scored event, so everyone has the opportunity to compare time and scores. ***Remember that safety is always first.*** With that, eye and hearing protection is required. You can go as fast as you feel comfortable, but any unsafe actions will not be tolerated and a shooter can be asked to leave the range. We encourage you to go to youtube.com to watch a match online. This will help give an unfamiliar competitor an idea of expectations and procedures.

This is an International Defensive Pistol Association style match. The I.D.P.A. will be supervising this event. As such, there will be a range orientation and a safety briefing by our certified range officers. ***Everyone will sign a shooting waiver.*** Stages in a *regular* I.D.P.A. match can have a round count of no more than 18 rounds per stage. Since this is not a regular competition, it is a shoot until you're happy sport. So if you're a trigger happy Marine, be prepared with extra ammo. There will be 4 different stages.

All competitors that come to the match ***must bring all firearms in their cases and unloaded since this is a "cold range" per I.D.P.A. guidelines.*** There will be no handling/loading of firearms until you are directed to do so by the range officer. We will rally on the rifle bays that are located beyond the clubhouse. At this point we will make all of our introductions and go to a designated safe area to put our firearms on our person.

- **PLACE:** Berrien County Sportsman's Club
- **ADDRESS:** 2985 Linco Rd, Berrien Springs MI 49103
- **WHAT TO BRING:** A pistol with holster, at least two (2) magazines (we recommend 3) with magazine pouch, and 100 rounds of ammunition.
- **PISTOLS:** All calibers are welcome from .380 auto up to .45 ACP with the most common being a 9 mm. 22 caliber pistols are ***not*** allowed. Pistols can be either semi-auto or revolver.
- **COST:** The fee will be \$10.00 to the I.D.P.A. along with a requested donation to the Wolverine Detachment. Your confirmation of attendance is needed by no later than August 15th to be eligible to compete. There will be only enough positions for up to 30 competitors. So first come first serve.
